The conference in autumn 2010

It was argued that the title “Diversities of Asian Dynamics” was too vague, and at the very least the meaning and purpose of this title should be defined to ensure easier approach and understanding for people who are interested. Instead the title “Copenhagen Asia Conference” was suggested. Ayo Wahlberg offered to write a describing text for the conference.

A tentative date for the conference was agreed upon and locations are being checked for availability (and whether it will collide with upcoming conferences/big arrangements in Copenhagen). The date set is 11-13 November 2010. The PhD course will run from 14-15 November 2010.

The conveners are to submit the panels’/workshops’ format, possible output, budget, number of participants as well as their suggestion for a keynote speaker at the ceremonial hall by **Friday 6 November** to Marie Yoshida. marie.yoshida@nias.ku.dk. Marie will send out guidelines.
